1. Welcome and apologies

In attendance were: BR, BW, CA, JA, JJ, JP, MP, MW, MG, SF, SP and CM.

SP reminded GIPC to be cognisant of competition law requirements in discussions and in its work.

SP asked if anyone has a conflict of interest in relation to an agenda item to declare this. None were raised.

2. Minutes of previous meeting

The minutes of the previous meeting held on 12 September were approved.

3. Actions from last meeting

An update on outstanding actions was given, as set out in the table at the end of these minutes.

4. Agenda discussion

- (a) APRA in DJ's absence (APRA's monthly PC update was distributed via email), GIPC discussed planning for the GIPC/APRA liaison meeting:
 - Potential topics suggested included: APRA's resumption of GI statistics, feedback on its corporate plan, risk margins (what data would be useful to industry), general feedback and expectations from APRA of GIPC, general update to APRA on GIPC's activities
 - Will push this out after November GIPC meeting, to enable planning of this session
- (b) International Actuarial Association MW provided an update on recent IAA meetings:
 - July meeting covered updates from Estonian and Greek associations and a cyber overview
 - September meeting covered update from IAA's AI task force (set up 4 workstreams across

- October meeting covered overview of IAN 300 professional judgement (cross practice area note, however with practice area specific appendices), update from Ghana actuarial association and reserving practices (update from Australian's GI reserving WG)
- (c) Reserving working group MW noted that there are several initiatives underway. 3 Actuaries Digital articles are being drafted, expected to be released in early 2025. Also planning to do a call for volunteers at the upcoming AA forum for the risk margin subgroup
- (d) Natural perils BR provided an update on the Natural Perils WG's activities
 - Dr Joanna Aldridge's cat model evaluation paper it was previously noted that the upcoming Insights was targeted at a different level compared to Dr Aldridge's paper. JP is now working to find an Insights slot in 2025 for this presentation
 - Technical paper on cat modelling paper is continuing to progress. GIPC have reviewed the draft of this paper and feedback is being worked through. Paper will be submitted to PPCC
 - Insights will be presented at 31/10, with Yongjie Qi leading reserving and Sinead Keane / Kate Bible leading pricing. Insights will be pitched at people who are new to this area
 - BR will be stepping off GIPC at the end of 2024. SP is working on an ad to advertise for BR's replacement

(e) Other matters

• Institute's Chief Data and AI Officer – Alex Scandurra has been appointed to this role
